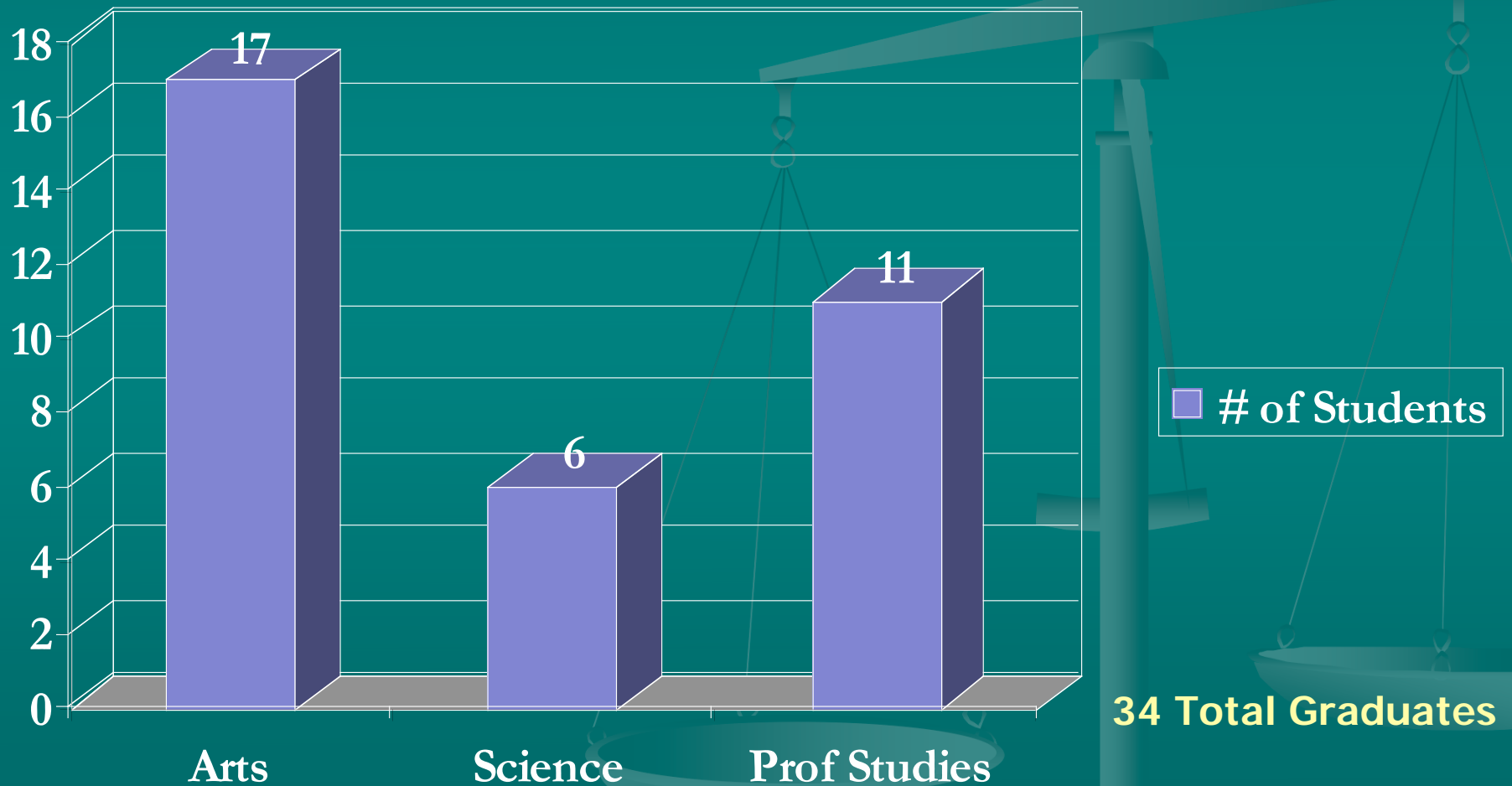


At Acadia most students with disabilities are model students; they are bright, dedicated and committed.

These students do what good students always have done...they go to class, do the work and ask for help when they need it.

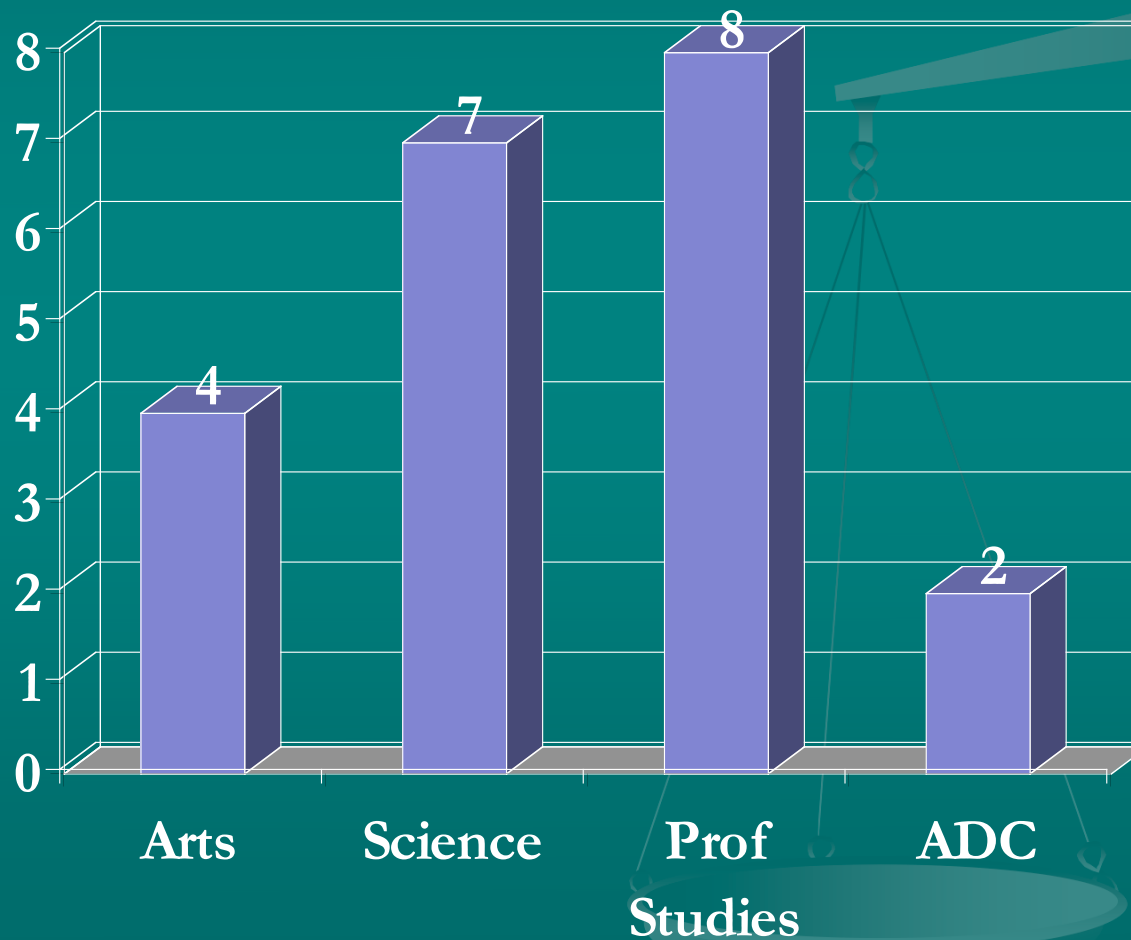

Average CGPA of Grads 06/07



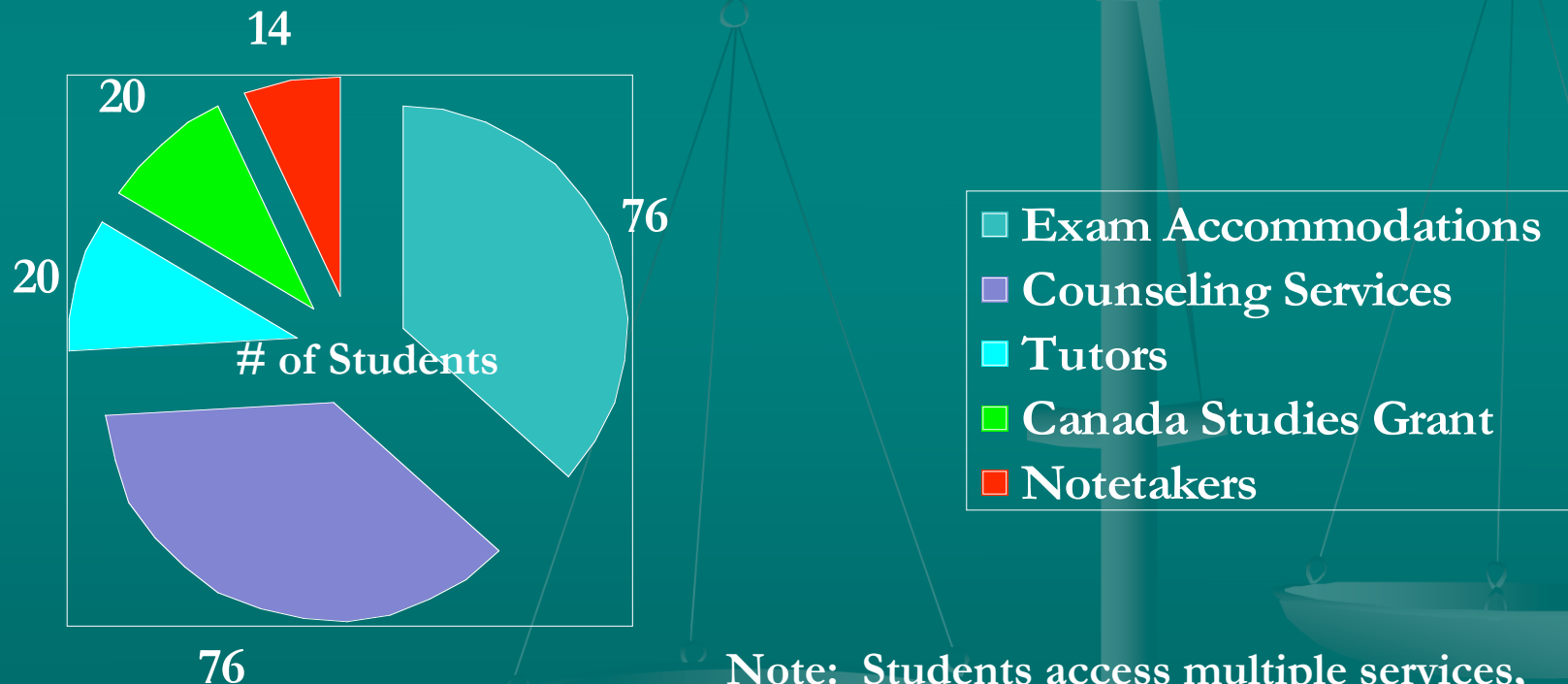

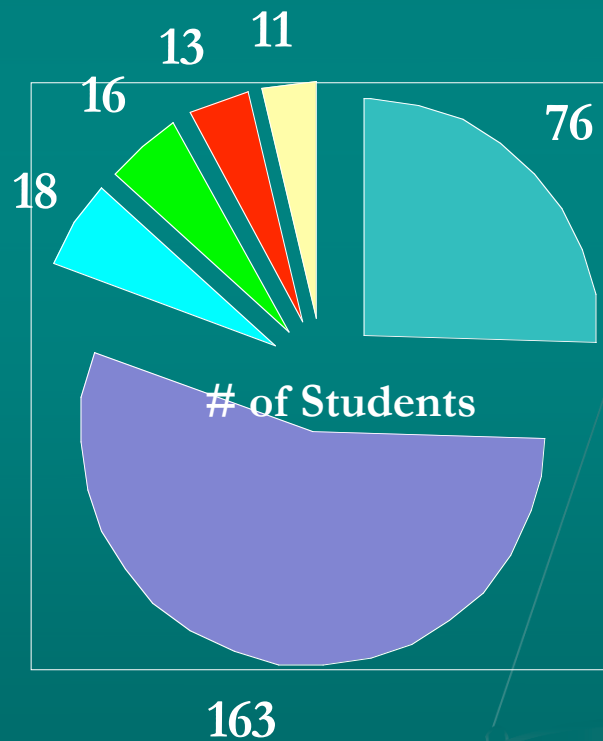
Disability Access Services Provided 06/07

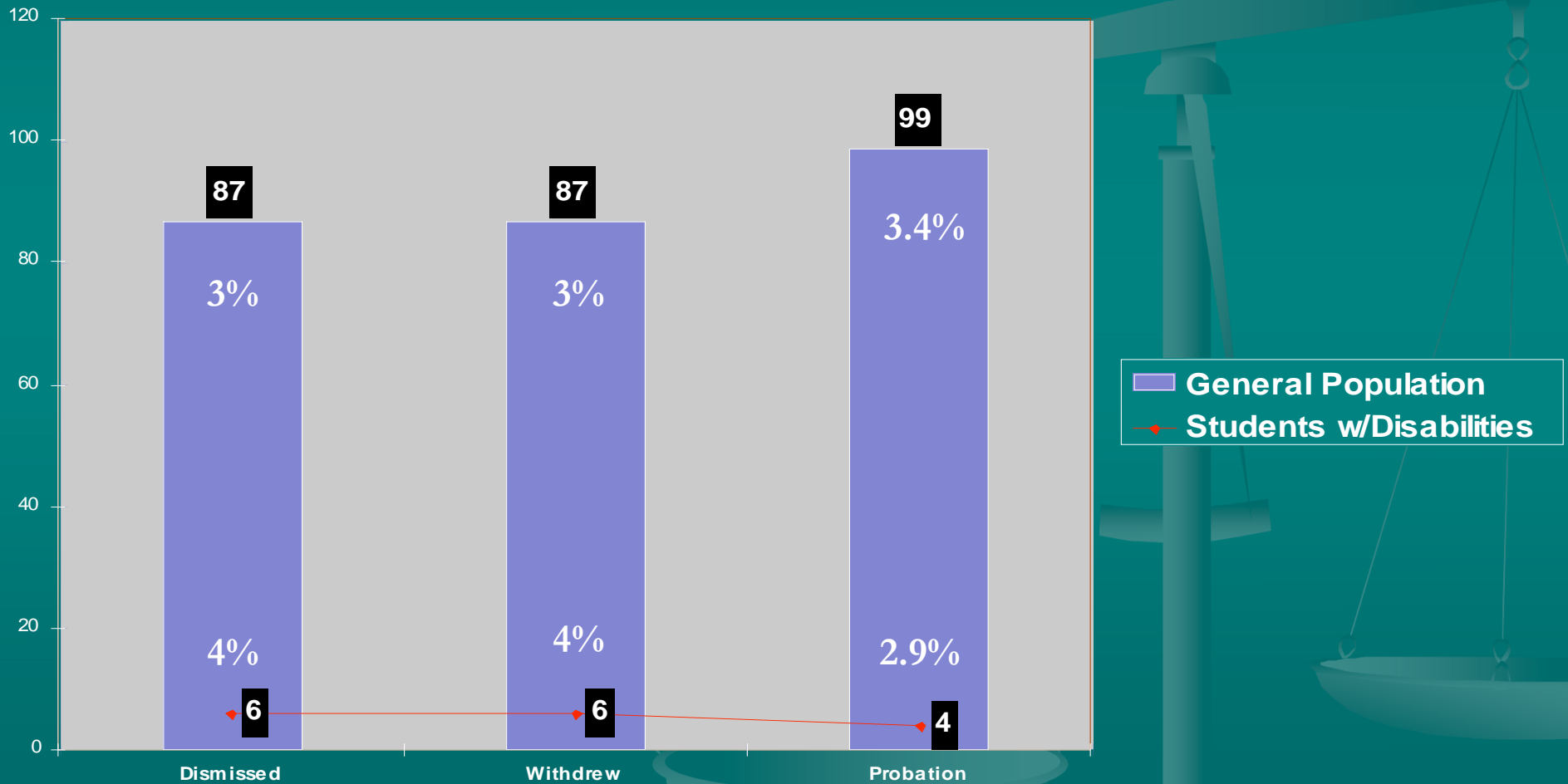

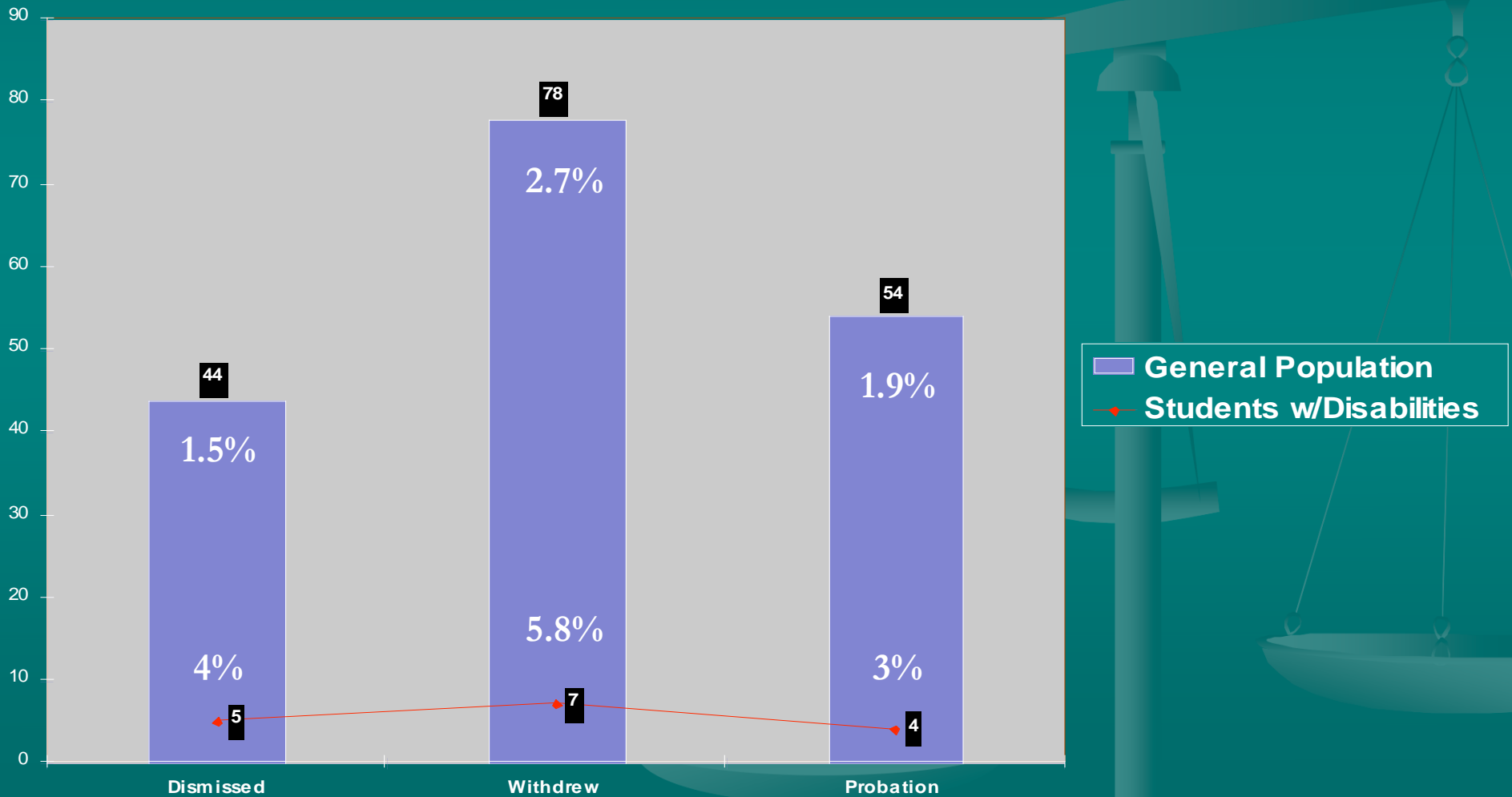
